Javik Blake, a 15-year-old aspiring broadcaster from Norton, MA, has been selected to be the first participant in the "Junior PawSox Announcer Program" and will call play by play in the 4th Inning of the club's first Sunday home game, April 10. The PawSox play the Buffalo Bisons today at 1:05 p.m.

Blake, a freshman at Norton High School, will join PawSox broadcasters Josh Maurer and Will Flemming in the top of the 4th and perform play by play in the bottom of the inning. The game is broadcast on WHJJ 920 AM and throughout the PawSox Radio Network, as well as accompanying the telecast on milb.com.

Javik (pronounced JAY vick) has been practicing play by play since he was 13 years old, and created the Lancers Sports Network. He has already called more than 50 games for his Norton High Lancers.

"Javik is a serious broadcaster, particularly for a 15-year-old," said PawSox President Dr. Charles Steinberg. "Having listened to the recordings he submitted, I would not be surprised if he pursued a career in baseball play by play. He is an awfully accomplished young man. We look forward to Javik being the first 'Fan in the Fourth on Sunday, April 10."
